Stanley has been with News 12 for more than 11 years, most recently as News Director of News 12 New Jersey, and has over three decades of experience in local news coverage across the country, including as News Director for WUSA-TV serving the Washington D.C. metro area, News Director at WGRZ-TV in Buffalo, New York, and Assistant Director at KUTV News in Salt Lake City, to name a few.

Jim Whiteman as News Director of News 12 Long Island will oversee News 12 Long Island's entire news organization, including all station staff and production for the network's linear and digital channels. Whiteman started his career at News 12 in 1986 as a photographer, and has held many roles at the network in various capacities, most recently serving as Assistant News Director for Long Island for the last several years. Whiteman has earned numerous industry awards throughout his News 12 career, including a New York Emmy Award.

Michael Schreiber, President of the Altice USA News group which includes News 12, said "Manoj, Randal, and Jim are vital members of News 12 and have played an important role in the success of the networks for many years, elevating News 12's coverage through their expert reporting skills and storytelling abilities. These promotions are well deserved and will help to further position News 12 as the standard in hyperlocal journalism."
